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
Baum Realty Group, LLC has been exclusively retained to offer for sale the former Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary parish at the southwest corner of 24th Boulevard and California Avenue in Chicago's Little Village neighborhood (the "Property"). The Property encompasses a total of 48,194 SF of land and is improved with two buildings, a part two-story, part three-story concrete and masonry constructed church / school building of $\pm 25,000$ SF, and a two-story rectory building of $\pm 4,500$ SF.

An additional adjacent parcel containing 10,554 SF of land and a twostory convent of $\pm 3,900$ SF is not included in the offering but may be separately available for purchase. The entire site is zoned RT-4.

The church / school building is fully sprinklered and contains a congregation and ancillary space on the ground floor and classroom / school conditions on the upper floor. The building also contains a partial English basement with auditorium / recreation space. Ceiling heights in the building range from 10.5 ft to 12.5 ft. The rectory building has two stories with a finished basement and is currently occupied by a non-profit organization affiliated with ownership. Both buildings will be delivered vacant at closing.

The Property also includes ±20,000 SF of paved parking in total, along with two (2) single story garage structures. Vehicular access to the buildings is via a driveway off California Avenue, along with alley access in the rear of the site.

The Property is located one mile north of I-55 and accessible via public transit, roughly ½ a mile from the CTA Pink line (California Station) and conveniently accessed via a number of CTA bus routes including a bus stop on California only 1 block from the Property.


























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






















Little Village

I-55 provides easy access to Downtown Chicago and the western suburbs.


