






Ground Floor Retail Plan

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Wicker Park / Bucktown

The Flat Iron Arts Building is situated at the center of Wicker Park / Bucktown, a pair of synonymous neighborhoods famous for their unparalleled shopping, esoteric book stores, coffee houses, art galleries, specialty stores, cocktail bars, trendy restaurants, and entertainment venues. There's no better area to sip and shop in the country.









Over the last decade, the area has become one of Chicago's most coveted neighborhoods. Popular galleries, nightlife, and restaurants have made the area a coveted destination for young professionals and their growing families. In 2014, the neighborhood was ranked the "Best of Chicago" by Chicago Reader. In 2018, Wicker Park was named among the Top 25 most exciting urban neighborhoods in America according to reports by Digital Third Coast and HotSpot Rentals.

With retail, dinning, and entertainment options lining both sides of the streets, North, Damen and Milwaukee Avenues have a high density of pedestrian and vehicular traffic. Excellent public transportation further supports the area as a go-to shopping and dining destination for residents and tourist.

The popular shopping district attracts notable national brands including Shinola, Yeti, and lululemon.
